My child aged out of Early Intervention. Can we still receive support?

The CSC's programs are not dependent on EIS enrollment. We provide support from birth to the twilight years.

We don't live on Oahu. Will you still support us?

Yes! The CSC Is a statewide program. We have service providers on all major Hawaiian Islands and can do distance support as needed.
