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


What are COVID-19 Impact Services?

COVID-19 Impact services are temporary services provided outside of the school day that are aimed at getting your child to the level where he or she would have been without school closures.


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


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How are COVID-19 Impact Services delivered?

Temporary and high impact specially designed instruction or related services delivered beyond the school day. Possible examples:

- In-person:
 - O small-group
 - O skill-based before or after-school intervention sessions
 - O tutoring
- Online:
 - O individual or small-group
 - O skill-based before or after-school interventions or learning labs
 - O tutoring

How can I prepare for the meeting?

Before the meeting:

Gather any information on all areas identified in your child's IEP

- o Observations
- o Photographs
- o Recordings
- o Correspondence
- o Anecdotal notes
- o Reports
- o Data



How can I prepare for the meeting?

Before the meeting:

- Check that devices are fully charged
- Check Wifi connection
- Find a quiet space with good lighting
- Dress as you would for an in-person meeting



How can I prepare for the meeting?

During the meeting:

- Be prepared for the meeting 10-15 minutes prior
- Check yourself and your emotions
- Be a good listener
- Ask questions
- Discuss your concerns
- Clarify team agreements
- Ask Care Coordinator when the PWN will be completed



Quarter 1 Deadline

- There is flexibility.
- Accurate and sufficient data is needed to make determination
- You can ask for an IEP meeting at any time.
