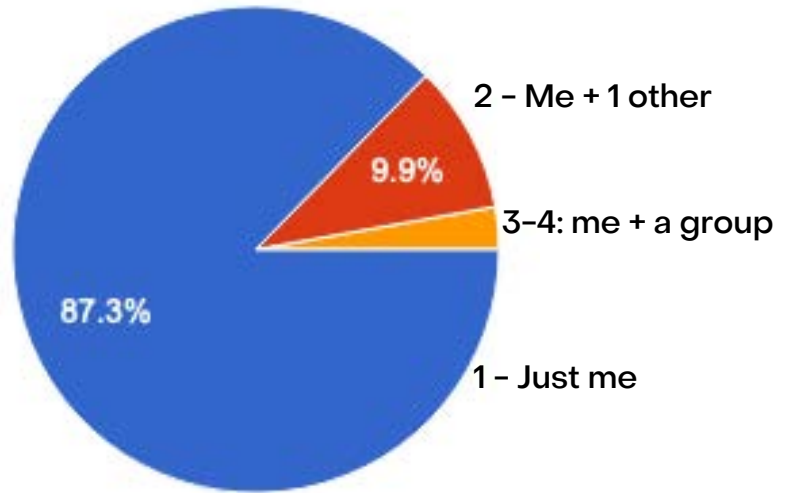

Tips, resources and creative suggestions.

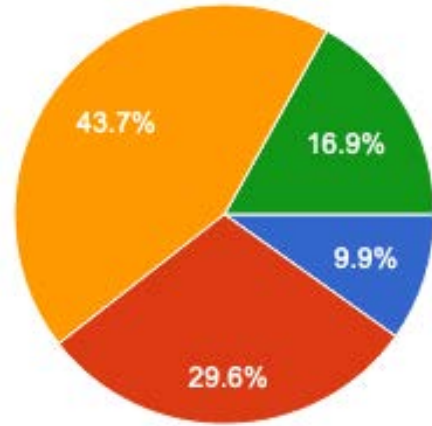
All the workshops were inspiring and informative.

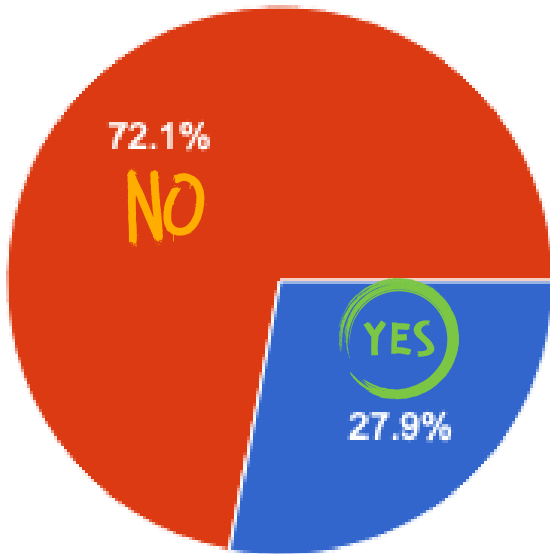
